Walk in registration deliveries will be dated the following day of delivery to insure fair registration. Every teaching space in the School of Religion is planned for. In order to meet the needs of our families, we have absolutely maximized every possible space that we have available in our building.

School of Religion Calendars and classroom and grade level information will be ready for pick up Monday, July 25th from 9:00 A.M. – 7:00 P.M. We have planned for one main day for calendar and registration pick-up. Thank you for helping us with our new procedure to help you receive your calendars early and save the School of Religion postage. Please plan early to pick up your packets.

As we build classes for the new school year, we will plan for **ten students per catechist** – as has always been our policy. Classroom assignments will be considered with respect to specific needs addressed in the privacy page of your registration forms as best as possible. Classes will find a mix of students from different schools. We are very proud of our young people who embrace the opportunity to build community through diversity.

We are very grateful to you for helping your child complete their "**Living My Faith**" pages and returning them to their catechist for recognition. This level of communication continues to show considerable improvement and appreciation indicates that you enjoy reviewing your child's lesson and praying with them. "*Living My Faith*" time offers you an opportunity to enter into comprehensive conversation about the theme of the unit studied and help your child express their understanding of material learned. We will continue to send important **Unit Reviews**, Loyola Press updates and notices about your *Finding God* Family ENewsletters, **Calendar Updates** and **Parish Announcements** through the **Grade Level Communication Envelopes**.

You will notice a significant change in our tuition fee schedule. Expenses have simply gone up. We are committed to respecting these economic times; however, in order to meet our rising costs we need to increase our fees. At first glance you might be shaken by a \$30.00 increase on our fee schedule. Gail and I are working steadfastly to get you all of your registration materials and prepare to print the calendar for an early pick up. In order to plan for our classes within the paradigm that offers the best environment for faith formation we need to be prepared on time as well. With your help, prayer, and volunteer spirit, we should have our classes in place with catechists ready for orientation, preparation and a great start. **Those families who pay their tuition upon returning their registration forms by June 30, 2011 will have their tuition reduced by \$25.00.** The material and sacramental fees will remain the same. St. Julian Eymard continues to offer one of the lowest tuition rates in the northwest suburban area. We pledge to respect our families and help you form the faith of your children in a tradition of excellent education, prayerful formation and spirit filled preparation for reception of the sacraments. **We respect your need to be on a fee payment schedule or other assistance with tuition.** Please register your children and contact us to make arrangements.
